Results Summary

- Fundraising in 2020 has been significantly negatively impacted due to the pandemic, however some progress has been made with various adapted efforts made to raise funds despite COVID-19 limitations
 - Icebreaker, Moncton and NSPA events in 2020 were not held
 - Saint John held a limited in-person event in the Fall that generated higher than usual net proceeds
 - Fredericton held a virtual event and live auction in the Fall that raised significant funds but well short of usual proceeds
 - Hartland held an online auction and fundraiser drive in late Fall that generated a comparable amount to the average of the last 3 years
 - A Fall fundraising event was held in Moncton hosted by MSA Director Jacqueline Girouard
