Silent Auction

Molly Joan Lamb Bobak was born on February 25th, 1922 in Vancouver, British Columbia. She studied art at the Vancouver School of Art from 1938-1941 with Jack Shadbolt and Charles Scott. In 1942 she joined the Canadian Women's Army Corps and became the first Canadian female war artist in 1945. On her return to Canada in 1946 she married Bruno Bobak and together they moved to Fredericton, New Brunswick. Bobak's paintings are in many collections around the world, but she was also an accomplished illustrator and teacher. She worked for many national and provincial arts organizations such as the National Film Board of Canada, and she served on the National Gallery's Ottawa Advisory Board.
