Field Technician Position**

**Overview**

The Miramichi Salmon Association is seeking two capable individuals to fill short-term positions conducting conservation work on the Miramichi River.

**Terms**

40 hours/week for 11 weeks

Electrofishing - 5 weeks

Beaver Dam Management - 6 weeks

**Start Date**

August 26th, 2024 - Electrofishing

September 30th, 2024 - Beaver Dam Management

**Wage**

\$17/hour from August 26th - September 27th for Electrofishing

\$20/hour from September 30th - November 8th for Beaver Dam Management

**Education Requirements**

There are no education requirements for this position.

**Certification Requirements**

Applicants must have a valid Class 5 Driver's License. First Aid certification is an asset.

**Skill Requirements**

Applicants must be able to navigate using GPS. Applicants should be comfortable handling fish and working in waders around water. Applicants should be mobile and able to traverse difficult terrain. Familiarity with the Miramichi watershed and surrounding areas is an asset. Applicants able to canoe will be given preference.

**Job Responsibilities**

Successful applicants will be conducting electrofishing surveys and beaver dam management throughout the Miramichi watershed. Responsibilities will include assisting with surveying electrofishing baseline sites, and assisting with scouting, assessing, and notching beaver dams.
